



Articulation Agreements: By Program

- Students must graduate from high school
- Students must always meet all college entrance requirements and any additional criteria
- Advance credits are based on (in most cases) completion of the two-year Barry Tech Program

Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)

At NASSAU BOCES:
 GPA - minimum 80%
 When applying: Include letter of recommendation from Automotive Technology teacher along with application
 Submit Portfolio

Review all of the above with Alfred State advisor within 5 days of start of semester.

AT COLLEGE:
 Must matriculate into Auto Trades Dept.
 Must maintain minimum 2.5 GPA

No credits, but based on evaluation may learn more advanced skills

May opt to pursue individual interests within course or "sample" course work in a separate curriculum

At NASSAU BOCES:

GPA - minimum "B"

Teacher must complete and return "Teacher Recommendation Form for College Credit"

At COLLEGE:

Credits awarded only if student has a GPA of 2.0 or better for first semester.

At NASSAU BOCES:

Must complete 2 year course

GPA - minimum "B" Average in Technical Courses

Must be approved by student's instructor and counselor

Application form - signed by Barry Tech Principal and mailed to Registrar of College

At COLLEGE:

AUT126 – Suspension and Steering = 6 credits

AUT127 – Hydraulic Brake Systems = 6 credits
