<p>At NASSAU BOCES: Certificate of Completion Written recommendation from Barry Tech Instructor Must provide documentation verifying successful completion of FAA Private Pilot Knowledge Exam MUST pass proficiency exam, with score of minimum 80%, for course in which advance placement credit is sought</p> <p>At COLLEGE: AER 1001 - General Aeronautics = 3 credits AER 1003 - Aviation Weather = 3 credits</p>

At NASSAU BOCES:

Pass FAA Private Pilot Written Knowledge Exam

Certificate of Completion
