At NASSAU BOCES:
Must complete program

Must be accepted into Building Trades Department
Will graduate with an Associate of Occupational Studies degree
Qualified students may enroll in Entrepreneur program

BLCT1142 - Masonry I = 2 credits
(To receive credit students must score 85% or better in course. Written exam may also be given.)

At NASSAU BOCES:
GPA - minimum "B"
Must submit written recommendation on college Application/Verification form.

Must take 12 credits or complete one semester at college with a minimum grade of "C" in all courses before credit is awarded.

CT122 - Framing I = 3 credits
CT123 - Framing II = 3 credits

Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)

At NASSAU BOCES:

Complete courses with an "A" or specified competencies with a "B".

Complete and send in "Teacher Recommendation for College Course Credit Form".

At COLLEGE:

Must complete one semester at college with a grade of a minimum of a "C" before articulated credit is awarded.
