Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)

At NASSAU BOCES:
 GPA - minimum 85%
 Written recommendation from Barry Tech Instructor

At COLLEGE:
 Guaranteed admission into Equine Studies Division
 ANSC 116 - Equine Science Techniques = 1 credit
 ANSC 166 - Intro to Western & English Equitation = 1 credit (must demonstrate riding experience)

Total College Credits

Maximum: Up to 2 credits

Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)

At NASSAU BOCES:

GPA - minimum 80%

Signed “Certified Teacher Recommendation for College Credit”

Must complete one semester at college with a minimum of a 2.25 GPA before advanced credits are awarded.

At COLLEGE:

For Equine Science & Management (AAS) & Equine Racing & Management (AAS)

ESCI 100 Horse Husbandry = 2 credits for completion of 1 year program at Barry Tech (Nassau BOCES)

= 3 credits for completion of 2 year program at Barry Tech (Nassau BOCES)

Total College Credits

Credits:

1 yr. at Barry Tech - ESCI 100 = 2 credits

2 yrs. at Barry Tech - ESCI 100 = 3 credits
