**Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)**

at NASSAU BOCES:

Certificate of Completion for 2 year Medical Assisting program and high school diploma  
80% or higher at Barry Tech, some courses require a 90%  
80% or higher overall high school  
Completion of Teacher Recommendation for College Credit Form (in articulation binder)

at KATHARINE GIBBS:

Must meet all admissions requirements  
Have opportunity to test out for 2 more classes by scoring 75% or higher  
Financial Aid packet completed

MD240A, Anatomy & Physiology, 90%+ = 3 credits  
MD150, Patient Care I, 80%+ = 3 credits  
MD233A, Medical Terminology= 3 credits
