<p>At NASSAU BOCES: GPA - minimum "B" (85%) Must submit written recommendation on college Application/Verification Form</p> <p>At COLLEGE: Must take 12 credit hours or complete one semester at college with minimum grade of "C" in all courses before credit is awarded.</p> <p>Nursing Elective = 3 credits (must have CNA Certification)</p>

Terms of Articulation Agreement (abbreviated)

at NASSAU BOCES:

Certificate of Completion for 2 year Nurse Assisting program and high school diploma
80% or higher at Barry Tech, some courses require a 90%
80% or higher overall high school
Completion of Teacher Recommendation for College Credit Form (in articulation binder)

at KATHARINE GIBBS:

Must meet all admissions requirements
Have opportunity to test out for 2 more classes by scoring 75% or higher
Financial Aid packet completed

MD150, Patient Care I, 80%+ = 3 credits
MD233A, Medical Terminology= 3 credits
